



## Bahelor's Button

Butter	55 gms
Sugar	55 gms
Sugar for coating	15 gms
Egg	1 nos
Flour	140 gms

### Method

- 1 Cream butter and sugar and beat in part of the egg.
- 2 Add flour working into the creamed mixture with as much egg as required until it binds together. Mixture should be stiff.
- 3 Form into balls. Roll in sugar and bake in moderately hot oven (375° F) until golden brown.
